
## COKO FARM, GRADE A1, SCR. 15+, WASHED, BOURBON/JACKSON

Coko Farm is located in the northern Gakenke District of Rwanda and was founded in 2008 by Jean Nepomuscene Habiyarimana. Growing up as a farmer's son, he understood early on how vital coffee cultivation is for his community, a realization that eventually led him to purchase his own land. Year after year, he continues to improve the quality of his coffee.

In addition, Coko Farm has been selected as a model farm for the Farmer Field School. For several years now, it has also been home to a large number of pigs, which not only help increase productivity on the farm but also provide valuable organic fertilizer.
